Our preschool theme this year is: **MUSIC GENRES**. Our preschoolers have enjoyed some amazing experiences in music. They've learned about the history of music, music appreciation, the greats and their contributions to music as well as music theory. They've enriched their learning through rhythmic movement exercises, instrumentation, storytelling, books, dance, art activities as well as listening enjoyment.

Our preschoolers are excited about sharing their world of learning with you. Parents are welcome to visit with their child anytime between 3:30 – 7:00 p.m. The children have chosen three Montessori 'jobs' which they will present to you. We ask that you take on the role of active observer and encourage their enthusiasm, keenness, and love for learning as they display their skills. We also ask that you complement their work with positive encouraging words.



It is beneficial for parents whose children will be entering Kindergarten the next school year to visit the Kindergarten classrooms and watch one of the presentations; 3:30 p.m. or 5:45 p.m.

KINDERGARTEN & ELEMENTARY



Our Elementary theme this year is also **MUSIC GENRES**. Music unites all of us no matter what our ethnicity, culture or religion. Our students have been studying the various types of conventional music identified as belonging to a shared tradition or set of particular standards. Our goal was to inspire our students and help them to develop an appreciation for Music in its full form. Instrumentation, Music Theory, History, Geography, Literature, research on the greats & their contributions as well as listening experiences have all been an integral part of their studies.

Our students will be demonstrating the Montessori material and its many facets of concept learning used in the classroom everyday that helps them learn concrete awareness of a subject matter. You will see a wide range of materials from Math, Language, Botany, Zoology, History, Geography, and Geometry. The children will welcome you into their classroom; introduce themselves, the material, and go on to explain its importance as well as its use. Not only will the children display their knowledge, but also their confidence and public speaking abilities.

We ask that you watch very carefully, listen to their words of wisdom and discover what an important role the Montessori philosophy & the carefully prepared environment has played in your child's overall achievement. They have worked very hard & are ready to show you what they do at school every day.

There will be two sessions; the first will start at 3:30 p.m. and the second at 5:45 p.m. Please take note of the posted schedule & make sure your child is back in school at the correct time. They may be working alone or with a partner. We are extremely proud of our children. We are confident that you will feel the same when you observe the skill & proficiency displayed in your child's knowledge of the materials as well as the amazing powers of concentration your child has so skillfully mastered.

Please remember that this is a very special time for our students. We ask that you turn off all cell phones and pagers while inside the classroom. Siblings are not allowed in the classrooms. They will be supervised on the playground by the daycare staff. Thank You for your cooperation.
