General Information



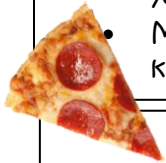
DROP - OFF & PICK - UP

Children must be signed in & out of class log upon arrival and departure from school on a daily basis.

Only authorized persons may pick up children from school.

Please inform the school if anyone other than those authorized will be picking up your child.

Make sure to give your child a big hug and kiss before leaving.



COOKERY DAYS

- Each class will prepare lunch once a week
- Please check summer schedule in each classroom for specific day.
- Children will take turns bringing ingredients to make lunch.
- Lunch is provided on cookery days.
- Please see posted menu and provide substitutes in case of allergies.



WHAT CHILDREN NEED EVERY DAY

- Water bottle
- Lunch daily (with ice pack)
- Sunscreen (applied at home)
- Cap or hat
- Running shoes. No sandals or flip flops



ON VERY HOT DAYS

- When temperature exceeds 90 degrees, or if there is a lot of smog/smoke children will stay indoors.
- Children may go outside to play in the late afternoon when temperatures are cooler. They will be encouraged to play in the shade under the trees or under the patios.



WATER PLAY AT SCHOOL

- Check dates on class schedules
- Apply sunscreen at home
- Bring towel & swimsuit
- Water toys are allowed



SUMMER CURRICULUM

Our summer curriculum is planned ahead of time for the 9 fun weeks of summer school. New students will be gradually eased into a regular classroom routine and introduced to group activities, games & the Montessori materials which they will work on independently. Older children will sharpen their Language, Math and printing skills as a preparation for the Pre K & Kindergarten class. Classrooms will have weekly schedules with all daily activities posted. Please be sure to check out all the fun activities your little one will be doing every week. Our teachers are always available to answer any questions you may have.

NON POTTY TRAINED CHILDREN

Our staff will work with all the 2 year olds to help them move on to pull ups and underwear fast. We ask that you please be consistent and keep the same routine at home. Please be sure to send diapers and wipes to be kept at school. A Diaper Changing Schedule will be posted in the classrooms.
