Physician's Reports

(Students may not enroll at Oneonta without a current Physician's report).

Preschool & Transitional Kindergarten Students:

- Every student needs to have a current **PHYSICIANS REPORT- CHILD CARE CENTERS** filled out by a pediatrician. (*Definition of current is after September 1, 2016 and before September 1, 2017.*)
- A copy of Immunization record is also mandatory. (Yellow Immunization Card)

Kindergarten Students:

- It is mandatory to have the **REPORT OF HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR SCHOOL ENTRY** filled out by a health care professional.
- A copy of Immunization record is also mandatory. (Yellow Immunization Card)

Elementary Students:

- **STUDENT HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM** filled out by health care professional.
